If the said election district for which he is appointed an officer of registration is or shall be divided into election precincts, he shall, at his sittings in July and August, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and at his September sitting in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and at his September sitting in each year thereafter, sit at some place in each of said election precincts convenient to the residents thereof on so many of the days designated by this act for his said respective sittings as will suffice to afford an opportunity for ascertaining and registering the qualified voters in each of said election precincts; the sitting in the month of October, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and in each year thereafter, shall be held at such one place in his election district as may be convenient to the greater number of the residents thereof; the said respective officers of registration shall sit at said respective sittings in any of the counties of this State from eight o'clock A. M. to seven o'clock P. M. on each day of their said appointed sittings.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the first sitting of the said respective officers of registration appointed to act respectively in the city of Baltimore, and in the counties of this State, is designated and referred to in this act as the "first summer sitting;" the first of the next two subsequent sittings of said respective officers of registration, provided to be held in each year, is in this act designated and referred to as the "September sitting," and the last of said two subsequent sittings of said respective officers of registration, provided to be held in each year, is in this act designated and referred to as the "October sitting."

Give collective
notice.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That said officers of registration appointed for the respective groups of election precincts in the city of Baltimore, or hereafter appointed for the respective wards of said city, shall give in each year a collective notice signed by such one of their number as they shall designate for that purpose, of their respective sittings to be held in said year, under the provisions of this act, and of the times and places at which such respective sittings shall take place; such notice shall be given
