Chapter 235.

AN ACT to pay William S. Taylor & Co. seven dollars and ninety-four cents due them for furnishing lumber for the use of Tobacco Warehouse No. 2 from April ninth to May sixth, eighteen hundred and eighty.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer payable to the order of William S. Taylor & Co. for the sum of seven dollars and ninety-four cents, being the amount due them for lumber furnished for the use of State Tobacco Warchouse Number Two, from April ninth to May sixth, eighteen hundred and eighty

Chapter 237.

AN ACT to add an additional section to section two of chapter three hundred and seventy of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An Act to provide a sinking fund for the payment of the bonded debt of Dorchester county, to be known as subsection two A."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an additional section is hereby added to section two of chapter three hundred and seventy of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to provide a sinking fund for the payment of the bonded debt of Dorchester county, to be known as sub-section two A."
