bonds.

Sub-SECTION TWO A. That in the event of additional bonds being issued by the Commissioners of Dorchester county for the erection of a new jail for said county, said commissioners, in lieu of investing the money required to be levied under section one of this act, in the manner designated and required in section two, may, in their discretion, looking to the public interest, invest any amount standing to the credit of said sinking fund in said new jail bonds; but said new jail bonds shall not be destroyed or canceled as is required in the case of said original bonds in section two of this act, but shall be safely held and kept by said commissioners in some secure place; and if in the opinion of the said commissioners it shall be necessary to reissue said jail bonds at a later date, the same shall be done, and the proceeds thereof applied to the extinguishment of the original debt, from which source they may have been temporarily diverted, leaving said jail bonds to be finally extinguished in the manner set forth in the law authorizing and creating said debt for the erection of a new jail in said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 238.

AN ACT to pay a sum of money to C. C. Magruder for services rendered the State.

Issue warrant.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant in favor of C. C. Magruder for the sum of three hundred dollars for counsel fees in assisting the State's Attorney for Prince George's county in the suit on a collector's bond of the State vs. Benjamin H. Becket and others before the Circuit Court for said county.
