of such stock as aforesaid is not paid within thirty days from the filing of such award and the confirmation by said court and notice to said company, the damages so found and confirmed shall be a judgment against said company and collected as other judgments in said court are by law recoverable.

Sec. 9. And be it enacted, That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act shall be and are

hereby repealed.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 244.

AN ACT to lay out and establish a new election district in Queen Anne's county, out of portions of the first and second election districts of said county, to be called Crumpton district, or election district number seven, and to submit to the qualified voters of said district the question whether the provision of the law prohibiting the sale of liquors shall be enforced in said new district.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new election district be laid out and established out of portions of district number one and district number two, of Queen Anne's county; the said new district to be known and called by the name of Crumpton district, or election district number seven.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the boundary lines of said new district shall run as follows: Beginning at the bridge spanning Chester river, at a place known as Turner's mills, above Sandtown, and following the public road in a southerly direction until it intersects the public road leading from Andover branch to Sandtown; thence with said road in a southwesterly direction to the forks of said road; thence with the left fork in a south-
