Chapter 271.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to amend article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," subtitle "Gaming."

Repealed and enacted in lieu

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter one hundred and fortynine of the acts of eighteen and eighty, entitled "An act to amend article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Gaming," by amending and reenacting as amended sections fifty-nine, sixty and sixty-six of said article thirty, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Not to keep gaming table. 59. Any person who shall keep any gaming table or other place of gambling in this State, or who shall deal at any such gaming table or other place for gambling in this State, or who shall in any way manage such gaming table or other place for gambling in this State, or who shall have any interest in any gaming table or the profits thereof, shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not exceeding five hundred dollars, one-half to go to the
