fied by his eath or affirmation, that the said pollbook is a complete list of the qualified and registered voters of said election district, or in said election precinct of said election district, and of the resi-

dence of each of said qualified and regisered voters, as the same are recorded in the registry of voters of such election district or election precinct as then made up, and that the entries in said registry of voters of the names and residences of the persons shown thereby to be qualified voters were made bona fide and according to the requirements of this act, and that no name has been omitted from or added to said registry of voters or poll-book contrary to the requirements of this act; and each of said officers of registration shall, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and in each year thereafter, within ten days after the close of his October sitting in any of said years, make or cause to be made in two proper poll-books, arranged as directed by the seventh section of this act, and endorsed and headed as directed by the ninth section of this act, two alphabetical lists of the names of the qualified and registered voters in the election district, or in each of the election precints of the election district, of which he is an officer of registration, as the same are recorded in the registry of voters of such election district, or of such election precinct in such election district, with the residence of each of said qualified and registered voters, as the same is recorded in the registry of voters of the proper election district, or election precinct in an election district, set opposite to the name of the said voter; and shall in the said year, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and in each year thereafter, within ten days after the close of his October sitting in any such year, deliver to the clerk of the Circuit
