

and erecting a court-house and jail thereon, and furnishing the same; and whereas the said sum was levied and collected, except the delinquents and insolvents, and paid to the commissioners for the time being; and whereas the levy list was paid by the collectors to the parties to whom due, and in the final settlement the insolvents and delinquents now deducted from the "Court-House" fund; and whereas the sums of money deducted from this fund during the years 1874, 1875, 1876, 1877, exceeds the amount of five thousand dollars; now, therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Commissioners of Wicomico county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to use so much of the "Sinking Fund" of said county heretofore levied and collected as may be necessary to pay in full the indebtedness on court-house, not exceeding two thousand dollars.

Use sinking fund.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the Commissioners of Wicomico county be authorized and directed to levy on the taxable property of said county, in the year 1882, a sum of money sufficient to repay said "Sinking Fund," with interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum till paid.

Levy on taxable property.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
