

and Delta Narrow Gauge Railway Company, with the Baltimore and Delta Railway Company, as authorized by the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1878, chapter 195, certified to by the secretary of State, under his seal of office, shall be evidence in any court of law or equity in this State.

What constitutes evidence

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That in case the Baltimore and Delta Railway Company should, at any time hereafter, under the provisions of this act, consolidate with any railroad company heretofore chartered, or that may be hereafter chartered under the laws of this State or under the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, such new corporation shall be liable for all the contracts, debts, obligations, engagements and liabilities, at law and in equity, of the respective companies form such union or consolidation, and shall hold, enjoy, occupy and be entitled to all the estate, real, personal and mixed, choses in action, &c., subject, however, to such lien or liens as may now be thereon, belonging to or due to each of said corporations forming such union, and may sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded on the several contracts, obligations, claims and demands of the companies aforesaid.

New corporation liable.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

Chapter 285.

AN ACT to repeal section three hundred and twenty-seven of article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Testamentary Law," and to re-enact the same with amendments, touching the recording and proof within this State of Wills admitted to probate and recorded elsewhere.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section three hundred and ninety-seven of article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Testa-
