SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That in advertising this loan aforesaid, the Governor, Comptroller and Treasurer, or a majority of them, shall cause to be published at the same time as part of each advertisement, section seven of this act, under the proper title and number of this act.

Chapter 290.

AN ACT to Protect the Election of Voluntary Political Associations, and to Punish Frauds therein, by adding certain sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, article four, title "City of Baltimore," under the new sub-title "Primary Elections."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following sections be added to the Code of Public Local Laws, article four, title "City of Baltimore," under the new sub-title "Primary Elections."

Sections added

SEC. ... *Be it enacted*, That all elections hereafter to be holden by any voluntary political association or party in the city of Baltimore, for any delegates or managing committee, or for the nomination of candidates for public officers, may be called or ordered by published notice upon a vote of a majority of the executive committee of such political association or party for the city of Baltimore, which may elect to accept the provisions of this act; said notice shall state the purpose, time, manner and conditions, together with the place or places of holding such elections, also the authority by which
