

Right to be present.

place, as candidates for nomination shall specially delegate, shall have the right, from the time of so inspecting said ballot-box until the canvass or counting of the ballots and signing of the returns, to be present at any and all times in the room occupied by said judges, in a position and place where they may fully, conveniently and comfortably watch the reception of and the deposit of every ballot cast at such elections, and the full and final canvass or count of the ballots, and signing of the returns; and no ballot-box or ballot cast, except it be in the ballot-box, shall be removed from the constant sight and inspection of such challengers until the canvass or count of ballots is completed, and the returns made and completed; and the said challengers, or any of them, shall have the right to challenge any person they may think they have reason to believe is not entitled to vote, and to sign a certificate, and to certify that the election, canvass or count has been or has not been conducted as in this act specified and laid down; and they may specify and protest against acts they may allege to be illegal, which certificate and protest, signed by any and all challengers, shall be appended and attached to the certificate of the judges and clerks of elections, and be returned therewith to whatever convention or committee to which the said judges or clerks are to return their said certificate; any judge violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the jail of the city of Baltimore or House of Correction not less two months nor more than four months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

SEC. ... *Be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the judges of such election to entertain objections made by any qualified elector under said published call or notice to any vote that may be offered on the ground that the person offering it is not entitled to vote under the terms of the said call for the said election, or that he is not a citizen of the United States, a legal resident and voter of the ward, or that he has received or been promised, directly or indirectly, any money, fee or reward for his vote for any candidate, or that he has voted before at that polling place or some other polling place on that
