and list relating to the registration of said person. If such person should apply for the same, alleging that he has acquired a residence elsewhere in this State, and that he desires the same for the purpose of being registered in the election precinct or election district in which he has acquired a new residence, he shall strike from the registry of voters, and from the list of qualified voters of the election precinct or election district in which such person is registered, the name of such person, and shall give to such person a certificate certified by his signature and official title, of the particulars of his said former registration from which his name has been so stricken, said certificate shall contain all the entries relating to the said former registration of such person, and shall show that the name of such person has been stricken from said registry of voters, and from the list of qualified and registered voters of the election precinct or election district in which he was formerly registered; when any person applying for registration at any sitting of an officer of registration appointed under the provisions of this act shall be found upon proper inquiry to have been previously registered within the State under the provisions of this act, the officer of registration to whom such application is made, before registering such person, shall demand and receive from him a certificate of his last previous registration made by the officer of registration or by the clerk of the court in whose custody the registry of voters and list of qualified and registered voters may then be in which such applicant was formerly registered, showing the entries relating to said person in such former registration, and showing that the name of such person has been stricken from the registry of voters and list of qualified voters in the election precinct or election district in which he was last before recorded as a qualified and registered voter, such certificate of previous registration shall be cancelled by the officer of registration who shall register such person anew.

Sec. 21. And be it enacted, That each officer of registration appointed under this act shall, within five days after each of the several sittings in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, make and publish in handbill form a complete list of all persons reg-
