istered at said several sittings, and shall, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and in each year thereafter, within three days after the expiration of his September sitting, and within the same time after the expiration of his October sitting, make, complete and publish two alphabetical lists, one of which alphabetical lists shall comprise the names of those persons whom said officers have stricken from any registry of voters or list of qualified and registered voters, delivered to said respective officers by said respective clerks of courts, and the other one of which alphabetical list shall comprise the names and residences of the persons whom said respective officers of registration have newly registered as qualified voters in their respective election districts or election precincts at their said preceding sitting, and also the names of those persons whom the proper judges or judge, acting under the authority conferred by this act, have or has ordered to be registered in said election district or election precinct; the said respective officers of registration shall cause said respective lists to be published by handbills posted in such public places as they may respectively select in their respective election districts or election precinets.
