striking off his name or the name of any other registered voter from the registry of voters or list of qualified and registered voters of such election district or election precinct, or being duly registered in the proper registry of voters of such election district or election precinct, by the omission of his name from the poll-book or list of qualified and registered voters of such election district or election precinct, or by misspelling of his name in such registry of voters or list of qualified and registered voters, or by the registration of any person in such election district or election precinct who was not entitled to be registered therein, or by refusing to strike from the registry of voters or list of qualified voters the name of any person who has ceased to be a qualified voter in said district or precinct since he was registered, or by the placing upon the poll-book of such election district or election precinct any name not entered or improperly entered as a qualified voter in the registry of voters of such election district or election precinct, he shall have the right to appeal forthwith from such decision or action to the judges or to a judge of the Circuit Court of the county in which such election district or election precinct is situated, in which such matter of complaint arose, or to one of the judges of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore city if such election precinct in which such matter of complaint arose is situated in said city, by petition verified by his oath or affirmation, at any time before the time appointed by law for delivering the poll-book or list of qualified and registered voters of such election district or election precinct to which his petition may relate, to the judges of election of such election district or election precinct; such petition shall fully state the matter whereof complaint is made. There shall be filed therewith, as exhibits, certified copies of all the entries in the proper registry of voters or list of qualified and registered voters of such election district or election precinct which relate to the subject matter of said petition, and the officer of registration of such election district or election precinct, and the clerk of the Circuit Court for the county in which such election district or election precinct is situated, or the clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city if such election precinct is situated
