section, for the year commencing on the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, or for any subsequent year, shall file a petition and certificate to a judge of the said court, as provided for in said last section, and the same proceedings shall be had thereupon as in said section prescribed; said petition may be filed either upon or after the first day of May of such year, or before; and if before, then it must be filed within thirty days before said day; but if any order of the judge to issue such license shall be filed before the first day of May, the clerk shall suspend issuing the same until such day.

Prosecutions  
—how made.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted,* That all prosecutions for violations of the provisions of this act may be either upon presentment and indictment, or by trial before a justice of the peace, who shall have jurisdiction, original and concurrent with the Circuit Court of said county, provided that any person who shall feel himself or herself aggrieved by a decision of a justice of the peace, in every case, shall have the right of appeal to the Circuit Court of Worcester county.
