Chapter 302.

AN ACT to repeal section one, chapter one hundred and fifty, of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors or Lager Beer, at or within three miles of the village of Savage, in Howard county," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one, chapter one hundred and fifty, of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, at or within three miles of the village of Savage, in Howard county," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

1. That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the Circuit Court of Howard county to issue a license to any person or persons, to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within the village of Savage, in the sixth election district of Howard county, or at any place in the said sixth election district, within a specified distance of two and three quarter miles from the Savage company's store house in said village of Savage.

Where unlawful to sell spirituous liquor.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective take effect from the date of its passage.
