SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the inhabitants of said Dames Quarter district, created by this act, shall be entitled in all respects to all the rights and privileges held or to be held or enjoyed by other election districts in said county, and all local laws, including the license act, or prohibitory liquor law, now in force in said Tangier district, shall remain in full force, and in all respects apply to said Dames Quarter district created hereby, as fully to all intents and purposes as though said license act or prohibitory liquor law were re-enacted in terms in this act.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

Chapter 307.

AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of certain districts of Queen Anne's county to determine by ballot whether Spirituous, Fermented or Intoxicating Liquors or Alcoholic Bitters shall be sold in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the question whether or not any person or persons, house, corporation, company or association may be permitted to sell any spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors of any origin whatever, or alcoholic bitters, at any time within the limits of election districts numbers two, three and five, or any one of said election districts herein designated, of Queen Anne's county, in this State, shall be submitted to the registered and qualified voters of said election districts hereinbefore designated respectively, at an election to be held on the seventh day of November, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and which election shall be held in
