said work and all expenses incident thereto shall not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars.

Enter into bond.

Levy special

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the county commissioners, before accepting any bid for the said work, shall require the bidder to enter into a good and sufficient bond, to be approved by them, for the faithful performance and execution of the said work.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That at the next regular levy-laying term of the said county commissioners after the passage of this act, they shall levy a special tax sufficient to defray all costs and expenses of the work hereby authorized, and of all incidental expenses necessary to the carrying out of the provisions of this act; provided, however, that the whole sum so levied shall not exceed the sum of five thousand dollars, and shall be payable on the order of the said county commissioners to the parties respectively entitled to the same.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 310.

AN ACT to pay Mrs. Eliza S. Jones, widow of John C. Jones, deceased, who was the only child and heir of Mrs. Dorothy Stover, deceased, the arrears of pension due the said Dorothy Stover at the time of her death, as the widow of Major John Courts Jones, a revolutionary officer.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby authorized and empowered to pay Mrs. Eliza S. Jones the sum of ninety-four dollars and sixty seven cents for arrears of pension, at the rate of sixty dollars per quarter, due Dorothy Stover at the time of her death, as the widow of Major John Courts Jones, deceased, a revolutionary officer, under resolution number thirty-three, passed December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-six, being from the first day of April, eighteen hundred

Treasurer authorized to pay
