Chapter 312.

AN ACT to repeal chapter four hundred and seventeen of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "An Act to give certain deeds wherein the amount of unpaid purchase money may be expressed, the effect of mortgage deeds, and preserve the vendors' lien in Allegany county."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act of eighteen hundred and seventy two, chapter four hundred and seventeen, entitled "An act to give certain deeds wherein the amount of unpaid purchase money may be expressed, the effect of mortgage deeds, and preserve the vendors' lien in Allegany county," is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall

take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 313.

AN ACT to encourage Manufactures in the city of Cumberland.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland be and are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretien, to levy for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-two and eighteen hundred eighty-three, at the time of making the annual levy for general purposes in said city, upon all the taxable property therein, a sum not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars in each of said years, for the purpose of securing the introduction and establishment of manufacturing enterprises in said city, said sum or sums, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, to be levied to and be expended by and under the direction of the committee on manufactures,
