SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 314.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Trustees of the Parsonage property in Chestertown of the Methodist Protestant Church to sell and convey certain real estate in said town.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Absalom W. Sparks, John W. Collins, William B. Usilton, John K. Aldridge and S. Franklin Smith, trustees of the Methodist Protestant Parsonage in Chestertown, Kent county, Maryland, of the Methodist Protestant Church of the Maryland district, or a majority of them, be and they are hereby fully authorized and empowered to sell and convey in fee part of said parsonage lot of land fronting on Fish street, in Chestertown, not exceeding thirty-six feet front by fifty-six feet deep, by deed to be executed, acknowledged and recorded according to law. Sell and convey.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
