or purchase all engines, cars, carriages and other conveyances and machinery of any kind they may think proper for the transportation of persons and personal property over and upon said railroad, roads or branches, or any part or sections thereof; and to run and drive the same upon and over the said railroad, roads and branches; and to do all other things which they may deem necessary and convenient for the transportation of persons and personal property over and upon said railroad and its branches.

Sec. 12. And be it enacted, That said company shall start and run their cars for transportation of passengers and property at regular times, to be fixed by the said directors, and of which they shall give public notice, and shall furnish sufficient accommodation for the transportation of all such passengers and property as shall, within a reasonable time previous thereto, be offered for transportation, at the place of starting, and at the usual stopping places fixed by said directors for receiving and discharging way passengers and freight for that train, and shall take, transport and discharge such passengers and property at, from and to such places on the due payment of the fare or freight legally chargeable therefor, and shall be liable to the party aggrieved in damages for any neglect or refusal in the premises.

SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That for the purpose of constructing and equipping said railroad and branches, the directors of said company are hereby authorized to borrow money to such an amount as they may consider necessary, the interest thereon to be paid semi-annually, and to issue their bonds therefor in sums not less than one hundred dollars, and to secure the payment of said bonds and their interest by executing and delivering to such trustee or trustees, as they may select, a mortgage of all or any part of the road, roads, branches, rights, liberties and franchises of the said company.

SEC. 14. And be it enacted, That on the completion of said railroad, or any section thereof, it shall and may be lawful for said company to demand and receive such sum or sums of money for toll and fare for the transportation of persons and property over saidroad as the Philadelphia, Wilmington and Baltimore Railroad Company is now entitled to charge.
