SEC. 9. *And be it further enacted*, That the said county commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to tear down and remove the present jail of said county, and provide temporarily, at the expense of said county, such accommodations for the sheriff of said county, and the prisoners committed to his custody, as they deem proper and expedient, until the new jail is completed and ready for use.

SEC. 10. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section forty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy six, chapter one hundred and five, entitled "An Act to repeal section forty-four of the Code of Public Local Laws," entitled "Prince George's County," under the title of "Collectors," as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and ninety-four, and re-enact the same with amendments, and to add additional sections thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section forty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter one hundred and five, entitled an act to repeal section forty-four of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Prince George's County," under the title of "Collectors," as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter two hundred and
