SEC. 26. And be it enacted, That every person whose name shall appear in said respective lists of qualified and registered voters, made at the October sittings in each year, of said respective officers of registration as amended by the order of the proper judges or judge, as hereinbefore provided, shall be entitled to vote in the election precinct or election district in which he is so registered, at every election held thereafter, until another registration of voters or correction thereof has been duly made and completed.

Sec. 27. And be it enacted, That the Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore shall detail police officers, and the sheriffs for the respective counties shall detail deputy sheriffs, by them appointed, sufficient in number to preserve order at the places in said city of Baltimore and in said respective counties where said respective officers of registration may be sitting for the discharge

of the duties of their respective offices.

SEC. 28. And be it enacted, That within one month before the time hereinafter provided for the first summer sitting of the officers of registration appointed in the city of Baltimore under the provisions of this act, the Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore shall cause a census of the qualified voters in each of the election precincts into which the several wards of Baltimore city shall then be divided, to be made by their police officers, and to be returned by said officers to the said board, and the said board shall furnish a copy of the list of qualified voters so returned as resident in each election precinct of said city to the officer of registration for such election precinct, on or before the day of the first summer sitting of said officer of registration, and such census shall be made and returned after the year eighteen hundred and eighty two, in the same manner and within the same time before the September sitting of said officers of registration in said city occurring before each election of members of the General Assembly; and copies thereof shall be furnished to the respective officers of registration in like manner as aforesaid.
