he was therefore unable to collect the taxes on said sum; and whereas it appears, by said petition and accompanying papers, that the said Watkins paid the taxes due the State on the full amount placed in his hands for collection, together with the interest thereon; and whereas section twenty-three of article three of the Constitution has been fully complied with, the Comptroller and Treasurer of the State having examined said petition and recommended the passage of a law authorizing the refunding of the sum of three hundred and fifty-eight dollars and sixteen cents to the said J. Maurice Watkins; therefore—

Preamble.

Issue warrant.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby requested and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to the said J. Maurice Watkins the said sum of three hundred and fifty-eight dollars and sixteen cents.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 319.

AN ACT to amend section eleven of an act entitled "An act to incorporate Washington, Colesville and Ashton Turnpike Company," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section eleven of an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Washington, Colesville and Ashton Turnpike Company," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 11. And be it enacted, That the said company be and they are hereby authorized to make branches to said road, not exceeding ten miles
