

in length for each or any branch, and that in regard to each and every branch so provided to be made, said company shall have all the powers and be subject to all rates, charges and regulations prescribed in relation to the main road.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the capital stock of the said company be and hereby is authorized to be increased at the rate of not over twenty-five hundred dollars for each and every mile of road built as a branch to the main road as provided for in section eleven.

Increase capital stock.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 320.**

AN ACT to add an additional section to the Code of Public Local Laws, article one, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Elections," to be numbered sixty-two B, and to follow section sixty-two A of said article, as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter two hundred and three.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an additional section be and is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws, article one, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Elections," to be numbered sixty-two B, to follow section sixty-two A of said article, as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter two hundred and three, said new section to read as follows:

Additional section.

62 B. If it shall at any time be deemed necessary to the convenience of voters in said county, or any part thereof, to sub-divide any of the election districts of said county into two or more election precincts, the county commissioners of said county shall have power so to do, and in such event to provide all necessary machinery for holding elections in said several precincts as if they were complete
