

election districts; and whenever any election district is so divided into two or more election precincts, it shall be the duty of the officer of registration for such district to make and keep up separate lists of qualified voters for each of said several precincts.

**Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 321.**

AN ACT to refund to Alexander R. Claytor certain money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury.

**Issue warrant.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer in favor of Alexander R. Claytor, late collector of State taxes in the first district of Anne Arundel county, for the sum of fifty-one dollars and sixty-six cents, erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury, as certified by the officers of the Treasury Department, and on the recommendation of said officers, as required by section thirty-three of article three of the constitution of Maryland.

**Effective.** SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
