called Cathedral street from the north side of Oliver street to North avenue.

Sec. 7. And be it further enacted, That in the proceedings for opening any of the streets which may be opened through the present Bolton Depot grounds, and in the proceedings for the closing of the portion of Cathedral street mentioned in the sixth section of this act, if any sum or sums shall be assessed to the Northern Central Railway Company for benefits, the same shall be paid by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

Sec. 8. And be it further enacted, That this act Effective. shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 324.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-five of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "Alms House," and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section twenty-five of article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "Alms House," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and

25. They may, out of the money so levied, keep any number of out-pensioners they may think proper, provided that no out-pension shall be allowed to any person who is not a fit subject to be received into the Alms House; and provided further, that a full and accurate list of the number of all out-pensioners shall be kept by districts, and the amount paid to each one shall be made out and included in the annual statement of their accounts to the County Commissioners, as required in section twenty-six of this article.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.
