

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That ballots for or against such sale shall have printed or written on them the words "For restricted license to sell intoxicating, spirituous or fermented liquors," or "Against license to sell intoxicating, spirituous or fermented liquors," and the ballots so cast shall be carefully counted by the judges of said election, and that said judges shall make a return of said votes and deliver said ballots to the clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county, and said clerk shall, within ten days thereafter, make proclamation of the result of said election, and cause the same to be published in at least two newspapers printed in said county for at least two successive weeks.

Mode of conducting election.

Make proclamation and publish result.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That if it shall be found by said returns of judges of election and proclamation of said clerk that a majority of said votes in said Dublin district have been cast against license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, that then in that event it shall not be lawful for any person or persons or body corporate in the said district to sell intoxicating, spirituous or fermented liquors, except cider and home-made wines, on the premises, when manufactured in quantities not less than a gallon, after the first day of January next, eighteen hundred and eighty-three; and any person violating the provisions of this section shall, upon indictment and conviction therefor, be fined not less than one hundred dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the county jail sixty days for each and every offence; and it shall be the duty of any justice of the peace for Somerset county, upon information received and confirmed by the oath of a creditable witness, to have any person violating any of the provisions of this section arrested and committed to the county jail, unless he or they shall give sufficient bail on recognizance, with securities to be approved by said justice of the peace, to appear before the Circuit Court for Somerset county at the next succeeding jury term thereof, to answer said charge.
