

istries of voters from which such missing list or lists was or were made up, or of such original list or lists, that said list or lists are not in the possession of the said sheriff or of said Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore, and said sheriff or Board of Police Commissioners aforesaid respectively shall receive the copy or copies of said missing list or lists when tendered to him by said clerk, and said sheriff or Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore respectively shall deliver, or cause to be delivered, on the day of each and every election, at the polls, at or before the time of opening of said polls, to the judges of election thereat, within their respective jurisdictions, a copy of the list of qualified and registered voters pertaining to the election precinct or election district over which said judges are to preside.

List to be furnished.

SEC. 31. *And be it enacted*, That the respective judges of election shall receive from the respective sheriffs of their respective counties, or from the said Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore, the lists of qualified and registered voters pertaining to their respective election precincts or election districts, and preserve the same without alteration, mutilation or defacement while in their possession; and shall, within two days after the close of their respective polls, in their respective election districts or election precincts, return to said respective sheriffs, or to the said Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore, the said respective lists of qualified and registered voters from them respectively received; and the said respective sheriffs and the said Board of Police Commissioners for the city of Baltimore shall, upon so receiving the same, forthwith deliver the same to the clerks of the respective courts from which the same were respectively received. The said respective judges of election shall not at any election receive or deposit in the ballot-box the ballot of any person offering to vote until they have found his name in the list of qualified and registered voters for their respective election precincts or election districts, delivered to them for the purposes of said election, and shall be satisfied that the person so offering to vote is the person named in said list, and have checked it thereon; and they shall receive and
