

liquors, that then and in that event the following section shall be added to article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset county, to refer only to said district under the sub-title "Sales of spirituous or fermented liquors in Dublin district," to take effect on the first day of May, eighteen hundred and eighty-three.

Section added.

No person shall obtain license.

SUB-SECTION 1-1. No person in said Dublin district, in Somerset county, if there shall be a majority for restricted license in said district at the election aforesaid, shall obtain a license for the sale or barter of spirituous or fermented liquors in any manner whatever, except such as shall be qualified as hereinafter provided.

First obtain license.

SUB-SECTION 2-2. Any person in said Dublin district, if there shall be a majority for restricted license at the election aforesaid, as before set forth in this act, who may desire to obtain a license to sell or barter intoxicating, spirituous or fermented liquors under the provisions of this act, shall first obtain from the clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county a license to sell goods, wares and merchandise, and who shall at the time of obtaining said last mentioned license, make oath before said clerk that his said stock of goods, wares and merchandise is worth at least the sum of five hundred dollars, under the provisions of the general law of this State, in case of license to sell goods, wares and merchandise.

Present petition to clerk.

SUB-SECTION 3-3. Before any person can obtain a license under the said sub-section of this act for said Dublin district as above specified, he shall present his petition to the clerk of the Circuit Court for Somerset county, duly sworn to by said applicant, in which he shall state that he has obtained the license required by the next preceding section of this act, that he will not violate any of the provisions of this act, and that he will keep an orderly place for the sale of the liquors which said license may authorize him to sell, with which said petition said applicant shall file a written certificate of at least twelve freeholders, residents of said Dublin district, setting forth their belief that the said applicant for such license will keep an orderly house and duly observe the provisions of this act.
