

**SUB-SECTION 4-4.** Before any person can obtain a license under this act in said Dublin district, in addition to complying with the preceding sections, shall also be required to pay to said clerk, for said license, for each place of sale of intoxicating liquors as aforesaid in said district, the sum of money which is now or which may hereafter be required by the general law of this State to be paid into the treasury of the State, and shall, in addition thereto, pay the said clerk for said license the sum of twenty dollars, to be paid by said clerk to the Board of County School Commissioners of Somerset county, to be by said board applied to and used as a part of the public general school fund of said county; and all licenses issued under this act shall expire on the first day of May next thereafter; and whenever all the foregoing provisions of this act shall have been fully complied with, and not before, it shall be the duty of said clerk to issue to the applicant a license accordingly to sell spirituous liquors, and the said license shall be transferable as traders' licenses now are under the general laws of the State; but nothing herein shall authorize any person to sell or barter any intoxicating, spirituous, vinous or fermented liquors to any minor, except upon the written order of his parent, guardian or employer; and if any person shall violate this provision of this act, shall, upon indictment and conviction therefor, be fined not less than fifty nor more than one hundred dollars for the first offence, and for each offence thereafter he shall be fined as above directed, and also be imprisoned not less than ten nor more than thirty days in the county jail, and his license may be suppressed, at the discretion of the court.

**SUB-SECTION 5-5.** No apothecary or druggist in said Dublin district, in Somerset county, shall sell, barter or keep on his premises, except for the private use of himself and his family, any spirituous liquors, wine, ale, beer, schnapps or any article used and sold as a beverage, in the composition or compounding of which whiskey, brandy, highwines or any spirituous or fermented liquors shall be the principal ingredient or ingredients; and every apothecary or druggist so doing shall, upon indictment and conviction thereof, be fined not less than one hundred nor more than two hundred dollars; but

Apothecary shall not sell.
