

deposit in the ballot-box the ballot of every person offering to vote whose name appears in said respective lists of qualified and registered voters.

SEC 32. *And be it enacted*, That each officer of registration or assistant officer of registration for any group of election precincts of Baltimore city, shall receive, subject to the deductions in this section provided, in the years eighteen hundred and eighty-two, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, four dollars per day for each day of his appointed service under this act which he shall actually perform. Each officer of registration appointed in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four, or thereafter, for any ward in the city of Baltimore, shall receive an annual salary of five hundred dollars for each year of his service; each officer of registration or assistant officer of registration in each of the counties of this State shall receive, subject to the deductions in this section provided, four dollars per day for each day of his appointed service under this act which he shall actually perform. Each officer or assistant officer of registration in the city of Baltimore and in any county of this State shall be paid the per diem which may become due to him in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two out of the Treasury of this State upon the exhibition by him of vouchers, verified by his oath or affirmation, satisfactory to the Comptroller of the Treasury of this State, showing that such officer performed in the said year the services for which such compensation is claimed. The said respective officers of registration shall be paid the compensation provided by this act after the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, if appointed to act in the city of Baltimore, by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, and if appointed to act in any county of this State, by the County Commissioners of said county. The clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city shall receive one cent for every ten words or figures of any copy of any list or part of any list of the qualified and registered voters in any election precinct in Baltimore city, or for every ten words or figures of any copy of any registry of voters, or part of any registry of voters, of any election precinct in said city, but the charge for a certified copy of the lists of all the qualified and registered voters, and of their
