court having jurisdiction of the same; and shall also be subject to indictment for said offence, and upon conviction of such offence shall be punished by fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Sec. 23. And be it enacted, That if the said railroad authorized as aforesaid shall not be commenced in five years from the passage of this act authorizing the same, and shall not be finished within ten years from the time of the commencement thereof, this act, authorizing the same, shall be null and void.

How null and void.

SEC. 24. And be it enacted, That the right and privilege is hereby reserved to any company heretofore or hereafter to be incorporated to connect with the railroad authorized by this act; provided, that in forming said connection no injury shall be done to the works or line of the property with which such connection is made.

Reserved

SEC. 25. And be it enacted, That the railroad company hereby incorporated may own and operate any line of steamships or steamboats, or may subscribe to or hold the stock of any company owning and operating such steamships or steamboats, when such steamships or steamboats can be used wholly or in part in connection with the business of said railroad company.

May own and operate.

Sec. 26. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly reserves the right to repeal, alter or annul the provisions of this act at its pleasure.

Reservation.

Sec. 27. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Effective.
