**Chapter 332.**

AN ACT to add certain sections to the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter one hundred and eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws," entitled "Garrett County," said additional sections to follow sub-section sixty-one of said act, sub-title "Sales by Auction," and to be numbered sixty-one A, sixty-one B and sixty-one C.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following sections be and are hereby added to the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter one hundred and eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws," entitled "Garrett County," said additional sections to follow sub-section sixty-one of said act, sub-title "Sales by Auction," and to be numbered sixty-one A, sixty-one B and sixty-one C, and to read as follows:

Sections added

61 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to pursue or carry on the business or avocation of an auctioneer or crier of sales in Garrett county, without first taking out a license therefor, as provided in the following section:

When unlawful.

61 B. Any person desiring to pursue or carry on said business or avocation of auctioneer or crier of sales, may obtain a license so to do upon application to the clerk of the Circuit Court for said county; and said clerk is hereby authorized to
