act, shall have a right to appeal within five days thereafter to the Circuit Court for Worcester county, and shall have a right, if he so elect, to a trial by jury; and the fines and forfeitures imposed and collected by any of the provisions of this act may be paid by said commissioners to the bailiff as compensation for his services, or the said commissioners may make such other disposition of said fines and forfeitures as they may deem best.

Fines—how disposed of.

Who to work on streets.

15. That the said commissioners shall cause each male inhabitant of said town, of twenty-one years of age and upwards, to work on the streets, lanes and alleys of said town, under the supervision of the bailiff, at least two days in each year, and as much oftener as they may deem necessary, not exceeding four days in one year; and if any person, as aforesaid, after having been summoned in writing one day previous to the day appointed by the bailiff for working the streets, shall fail to appear or provide some one in his stead, the said person, upon conviction before a justice of the peace, shall be fined seventy-five cents, and shall be required to pay the costs of said conviction; and the bailiff shall receive for his services, under this section, not exceeding one dollar per day that he is actually engaged in working said streets.

Bailiff's compensation.

Cause new assessment.

19. That the commissioners of said town may, whenever they think it necessary, from time to time, cause a new assessment of the real and personal property within the limits of the town, and for that purpose shall appoint two of the qualified voters of the town, being freeholders therein, to make such assessments, who, before proceeding in the execution of their duties, shall make oath before a justice of the peace that they will diligently and faithfully, without fear, favor, partiality or prejudice, assess all the taxable property within the limits of said town, taking as the basis of said assessment the market value of said property, according to the best of their skill and judgment, and the said assessors shall return to the said commissioners a fair copy of their assessment in a well bound book, written one month after their appointment, and shall receive for their work
