as assessors such compensation as said commissioners shall allow; and the said commissioners shall have power to alter and amend the said assessments whenever they think that justice requires it.

26. That the three commissioners now in office shall remain and continue to be commissioners of Snow Hill until the first election under this act, and until their successors are elected and qualified.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That all laws or parts of laws inconsistent with any of the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 336.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section eightyseven of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot county," sub-title "Fish."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section eighty-seven of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot county," sub-title "Fish," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 87. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful for any one to take or catch fish in the waters of Talbot county with seines having meshes of a size less than six inches around the square, or to land any seine upon the shores of any owner or occupant of land without the consent of such owner or occupant, nor shall it be lawful for any one, except bona fide residents of said county, to take or catch crabs from any of such waters of a greater depth than three feet; provided nothing in this act shall apply to citizens of Dorchester county fishing in the Choptank river.
