Chapter 339.

AN ACT to repeal section one of article thirteen of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to "Bastardy and Fornication," and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Repealed and enacted in lieu Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That section one of article thirteen of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to "Bastardy and Fornication," be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof.

1. Any justice of the peace upon information given him of any woman having an illegitimate child, may issue his warrant to a constable of the county or city, and the said constable shall thereupon take such person before some justice of the peace of the county, who shall require her to give security to indemnify the county from any charge that may accrue by means of such child, and upon neglect or refusal, shall commit her to the custody of the sheriff of the county, to be by him kept until she shall give such security.

Chapter 340.

AN ACT to regulate and establish the pay of the Bailiffs of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county.

Salary of bailiffs.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the bailiffs of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county be paid a salary of fifty dollars per month each in lieu of all fees.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said salary be due and payable by the County Commissioners of Baltimore county on the first Tuesday of each

and every month.
