Chapter 346.

AN ACT to authorize and enable Wm. J. Thomas, proprietor of the wharf at the foot of High street, Cambridge, Dorchester county, to extend and enlarge the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Wm. J. Thomas, proprietor of the wharf extending in the Choptank river from the foot of High street, in the town of Cambridge, Dorchester county, and built under a charter granted by an act passed at the session of eighteen hundred and twenty-two, be authorized and enabled to extend and enlarge the same as follows:

Extension of wharf.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That the extension and enlargement of said wharf shall commence at a point at the foot of High street, on the southern point of the said wharf, connecting with said street, and running the same course of said street towards the channel of the Choptank river, north fifty-one degrees east, until it reaches a point where this line is intersected by another line running a northerly direction from the outer or river line of the pier, at the end of said wharf, and parallel with said pier, so that the outer or river line of this enlargement and extension, and the outer or river line of the said pier, shall be one and the same straight line, and no deposit of shells or any other impediment to free navigation shall extend beyond this said line, and the said extension and enlargement, when completed, shall be the property of the said William J. Thomas.

Where to commence.

Not to deposit shells, &c.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
