provide by ordinance, to be adopted at the present session of the City Council of Baltimore, the proceeds of said bonds or certificates of indebtedness to be applied to the exclusive purpose of constructing and completing Lake Clifton, as proposed to be constructed on the line of the work for the introduction of the water of the Gunpowder Falls to the city of Baltimore, and for procuring and laying iron pipes or mains for the purpose of distributing said water to and among the inhabitants of said city; provided, however, that the said bonds or certificates of indebtedness shall not be issued until the ordinance, which the said Mayor and City Council of Baltimore are hereby authorized to enact providing for such issue, shall be approved by a majority of the legal voters of said city cast at the time and places to be appointed by said ordinance in the provision for submitting the same to the legal voters of said city, as required by section seven, article eleven, of the constitution of Maryland.

Chapter 352.

AN ACT to incorporate the Wyoming Cattle Company of Baltimore City.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Oscar F. Bresee, F. C. Latrobe, John M. Denison, Charles W. Slagle, John W. Hall, T. Edward Hambleton, of the State of Maryland, and Frank S. Hambleton, of the Territory of Wyoming, their associates, successors and assigns, be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name and style of the "Wyoming Cattle Company," and by that name shall be capable in law to hold and dispose of property, real, personal and mixed, fee simple and lease hold; to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded, to answer and defend, and be answered and defended
