SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That said company may make any change in its name by filing a certificate duly acknowledged by the President of the Company, in the office of the clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, which shall be recorded in the same manner as certificates of incorporations.

Chapter 353.

AN ACT to permit William E. Johnson, of Queen Anne's county, to build a pile bridge across the water separating Johnson's Island from the land of Miss Mary Wright.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That William E. Johnson, of Queen Anne's county, his heirs or assigns, are hereby empowered and permitted to build a pile bridge across the water separating Johnson's Island, in Queen Anne's county, Maryland, from the land of Miss Mary Wright, of said county.
