State, which may be necessary or proper for said corporation in carrying on its operations; and generally to do every other act or thing not inconsistent with law, which may be necessary to promote the objects and purposes for which the said association is formed; the committee of management and the board of trustees may each adopt such constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations as may be deemed proper and necessary to accomplish the objects of the association entrusted to these respective boards that are not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Maryland and of the United States; and they may, from time to time, alter, amend or repeal any provision of the constitution or by-laws, rules and regulations; such by-laws or constitution may prescribe the terms and conditions on which members of the association and the beneficiaries thereof shall become entitled to the benefits provided by the association; by reason of the guarantee of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company, herein provided for, no constitution, by-law, rule or regulation, nor any amendment, modification or repeal thereof, shall have any force until the same shall be approved by the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company. The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company is authorized, from time to time, to give such aid to said association by contributions of money or otherwise, and on such terms and conditions as the president and directors may prescribe.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and shall be subject to amendment, modification or repeal by the Legislature of this State.
