

**Chapter 369.**

AN ACT to repeal section one hundred and fifty-nine of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Sheriff," and to re-enact said section with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section one hundred and fifty-nine of article one of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Allegany County," sub-title "Sheriff," as enacted by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter two hundred and eighty-five, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

159. He shall be entitled to forty cents a day for each prisoner committed to the jail of said county, and to the following sums for taking convicts to the penitentiary, to wit: For a single convict, thirty-five dollars; for two taken together, twenty-five dollars each; when more than two, twenty dollars each, to be levied as other county charges.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Allegany county be and are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to pay the sheriff of said county for boarding prisoners in said county jail at the rates named in this act, between the dates of the taking effect of the act of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter two hundred and eighty-five, and the passage of this act.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
