

Chapter 377.

AN ACT to change the dividing line between the sixth and seventh election districts of Worcester county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the dividing line between the sixth and seventh election districts of Worcester county shall run as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of the second election district, thence running with the western line of the second district to Nassawanga creek, thence with the county road, known as the "Salisbury road," to the line of Wicomico county.

Dividing line.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 378.

AN ACT to repeal section two of an act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, entitled "An act to amend the charter of the Union Plank or Turnpike Road Company," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two of an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-six, entitled "An act to amend the charter of the Union Plank or Turnpike Road Company," passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:
