

Chapter 386.

AN ACT to repeal section fifty-six of the Public Local Laws, title "Kent County," sub-title "Chestertown," passed on the first day of March, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, as amended by an act passed at the session of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-five, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section fifty-six, title "Kent county," sub-title "Chestertown," of an act passed on the first day of March, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, as amended by an act passed at the session of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter three hundred and fifty-five, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and
re-enacted.

56. The money which shall be annually levied by the County Commissioners of Kent county for repairing the streets, lanes and alleys of said town, shall be paid to the commissioners of Chestertown or their order, and shall be expended by them for that purpose, and they shall appoint annually in the month of May or June a supervisor of said streets, lanes and alleys, and the said county commissioners shall levy in each of the years eighteen hundred and eighty-two and eighteen hundred and eighty-three, for the use of the Commissioners of Chestertown, the sum of six hundred and twenty-five dollars, and annually thereafter such a sum not less than three hundred dollars, nor more than six hundred and twenty-five dollars, as the said county commissioners shall in their discretion, after conference with the Commissioners of Chestertown, determine to be sufficient for the repairs of said streets, lanes and alleys.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.
