Chapter 26.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to refund to Benjamin Phipps, administrator of James E. Phipps, the amount of taxes erroneously paid by him on the property of his intestate, when satisfied of such erroneous payment.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county be and they are hereby authorized to inquire and ascertain whether Benjamin Phipps, administrator of James E. Phipps, has paid taxes upon property which should have been stricken from the assessment books of said county, and if satisfied that such taxes have been erroneously or by mistake paid on such property, then the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to refund to said Benjanmin Phipps the amount so erroneously paid by him.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 27.

AN ACT entitled "An Act to pay W. R. Marshall Forty-eight Dollars due him for Furnishing Hoops for the use of Tobacco Warehouse No. 2, from April eighth to June third, eighteen hundred and eighty."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasury, payable to the order of W. R. Marshall, for the sum of forty-eight dollars, being the amount due him for hoops furnished for the use of State To-
