Chapter 397.

AN ACT to amend further an act passed at the January session, A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, of the General Assembly of Maryland, chapter two hundred and nineteen, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Monumental Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, by enlarging the powers of the said corporation, and changing its name to the Monumental Banking and Insurance Company of Baltimore."

WHEREAS by the act stated in the title of this act, a corporation was created under the name of "The President and Directors of the Monumental Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore," and by another act passed at the January session, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy, and entitled an act to amend an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, of the General Assembly of Maryland, chapter two hundred and nineteen, entitled an act to incorporate the Monumental Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, and to change the name of said corporation, and to enlarge its powers, the name of said corporation was changed to the Monumental Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That if the majority of the shareholders of the said corporation shall vote for and pass, on or before the first day of October next, a resolution accepting this act at a general or special meeting of the shareholders, of which meeting ten days' notice shall have been given by publi-
