

enact, shall be approved by the votes of a majority of the legal votes of the said city, cast at the time and places to be appointed by said ordinance in the provision for submitting the same to the legal votes of the city, as required by section seven, article eleven, of the Constitution of Maryland; provided, however, that said bonds shall not be sold for less than par; and provided, also, that said bonds, not exceeding the amount of five hundred thousand dollars, shall be issued in any one year.

Chapter 407.

AN ACT to refund to Ann E. R. Bennett, guardian of George N. Bennett, an infant, of Cecil county, certain sums of money erroneously paid into the treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the treasurer of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed, upon the warrant of the comptroller, to pay to Ann E. R. Bennett, guardian of George N. Bennett, an infant of Cecil county, the sum of thirty-seven dollars and seventy-one cents, being the sum paid into the treasury by the said Ann E. R. Bennett, guardian as aforesaid, on account of erroneous assessments for State taxes for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, and eighteen hundred and eighty, inclusive of each year, this bill having been recommended by the officers of the State Treasury.

Whom to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
