

Allowance to sheriff. SECTION 1. That the sheriff of Montgomery county be and is hereby allowed thirty-five cents a day, and no more, for keeping and boarding each prisoner committed to the jail of said county.

Effective. SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 428.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Allegany county to refund to Chosen Friends' Lodge, number thirty-four (34), I. O. O. F., certain county taxes paid in error.

Levy for taxes paid in error. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Allegany county be and are hereby authorized and directed, at their next levy term, to levy to Chosen Friends' Lodge, number thirty-four (34), Independent Order of Odd-Fellows, the sum of twenty-eight dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$28.67) as taxes paid in error.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 429.

AN ACT to add a new section to article eighty-four of the Code of Public General Laws of this State relating to Schools.

Preamble. WHEREAS there is a uniform appropriation made by this State to each county of the sum of twelve hundred dollars for academy purposes; and whereas Anne Arundel county has only an appropriation of eight hundred dollars for such purposes thereof—
