

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of this State, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, shall pay, on the first day of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and annually thereafter, to the School Commissioners of Anne Arundel county, the sum of four hundred dollars as academy fund, the same being in addition to the appropriation now received by them for such purpose, the said sum, when received by said commissioners, to be paid to the trustees of the "Anne Arundel County Academy."

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 430.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Charles county to refund to S. Francis Gardner, of said county, taxes erroneously paid upon the county levies for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-six, eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight and eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, amounting in the aggregate to forty-nine dollars and twenty-five cents.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Charles county are hereby authorized and empowered to refund to S. Francis Gardner, of said county, the sum of forty-nine dollars and twenty-five cents, for county taxes erroneously paid upon the levies for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-six, eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight and eighteen hundred and seventy-nine.
