

Chapter 431.

AN ACT to pay to G. W. L. Buckler, of St. Mary's county, the sum of twenty-eight dollars and seventy-six cents, for taxes erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State.

SECTION 1. WHEREAS G. W. L. Buckler, of St. Mary's county, has paid to the Treasury of the State of Maryland, through the hands of R. King Clark, Collector of State taxes for St. Mary's county, the sum of twenty-eight dollars and seventy-six cents, said sum being the amount of State tax on the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-two, and eighteen hundred and seventy-three, and eighteen hundred and seventy-four, and eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and eighteen hundred and seventy-six; and on the sum of two thousand dollars for the years eighteen hundred and seventy-three, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, eighteen hundred and seventy-five, and eighteen hundred and seventy-six.

SEC. 2. AND WHEREAS, it further appears, that the aforesaid G. W. L. Buckler had sold and conveyed the aforesaid property to other parties, who were paying State and county tax on the said property at the same time.

SEC. 3. *Therefore, be it enacted*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of the State for the aforesaid sum of twenty-eight dollars and seventy-six cents, for the use and benefit of the said G. W. L. Buckler, the same having been recommended by the officers of the treasury department.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
