much thereof as may be necessary; for printing the annual report of the Comptroller, one thousand dollars; for the traveling expenses of the State Tax Commissioner, eight hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for printing expenses and clerical services, stationery and postage, copies and other necessary expenses in the office of the Attorney General, to be paid on vouchers therefor duly exhibited to the Comptroller, thirteen hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the expenses of the Court of Appeals, five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; to the Commissioners of the Land Office, for office expenses, three hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for the postage of the Executive Department, the Treasury Department, the Land Office, the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Delegates, twelve hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; for fuel and lights for the public buildings and grounds, to be expended under the direction and control of the Governor, five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

INSPECTIONS.

For salaries of
tobacco in-
spectors, &c.

For the salaries of the five Inspectors of Tobacco in Baltimore city, eighteen hundred dollars each—nine thousand dollars; for the payment of the annual ground rent on the tobacco warehouse lots in Baltimore city, four hundred and forty-eight dollars and eleven cents; for the salaries of two Inspectors of Steam Boilers in the city of Baltimore, fifteen hundred dollars each—three thousand dollars; for the salary of Mine Inspector for Alleghany and Garrett counties, fifteen hundred dollars.

COMMISSION OF FISHERIES.

For salaries of
fish commis-
sioners, &c.

For the salaries of the two Commissioners of Fisheries, fifteen hundred dollars each—three thousand dollars; to defray the expenses of the Commissioners of Fisheries, as per act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter forty-seven, ten thousand dollars, or so much thereof as in the opinion of the Governor may be necessary.
